## Freedom & Liberty Worship Center Camp Guidelines

All guidelines are necessary to assure a proper flow within our camp. Any exception to these guidelines or additional guidelines deemed necessary becomes effective upon announcement by the camp director or camp leaders. The general position of the administration is that we love each camper individually and expect each to maintain the following guidelines and common rules:

1. **THE CAMP AREA** - Camp Boundaries will be further explained in the welcome hour for campers. Once a person arrives at camp, he/she is not permitted to leave without the Director's permission. If vehicles are driven to the camp, they must be parked in the designated area, locked and not returned to until the end of the camp.
2. **SOCIAL CONTACT** – Camp Hot Pursuit, is a great place to make new friends. We expect NO physical contact between members of the opposite sex. Fighting and bullying is not acceptable behavior at camp.
3. **MEALS** - Meals will be served in various locations. Remember to dispose of all trash and clean your immediate dining area.
4. **DRESS CODE** - The camper should note that this is a church camp and the dress code is conservative. We expect all campers will dress appropriately, therefore we do not set a specific code. At the same time, camp leaders will express clothing discretion as a group. Clothing with offensive prints is not allowed. Shoes must be worn at all times. **BRING A PAIR OF CLOSE TOED SHOES FOR ACTIVITIES!!!**
5. **EVERYBODY MUST** -
  - a. Respect and cooperate with all leaders and campers.
  - b. Participate in the camp schedule giving particular attention to being on time for each activity. A daily schedule will be furnished upon registration.
  - c. Do your fair share in keeping the grounds, room, and equipment clean, in place, and workable at all times.

## F&LWC POLICY

1. **ACCIDENT INSURANCE** - Campers are covered by a limited accident policy while at camp. This does not cover any pre-existing illnesses or illness incurred while here. It is strictly an accident policy. This is a secondary policy, it will pay only after your insurance has been filed.
2. **ADMISSION POLICY** - Camp Hot Pursuit is open to all who are regardless of race, gender, ethnicity or religious preferences.
3. **ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE TIME** - Camp will begin **SUNDAY, June 10, 2018**. You should arrive at 12:00. The camp ends on **TUESDAY June 12, 2018** at Freedom & Liberty Church, 171 Key St, Pilot Mt., NC at 5pm. Someone should be present to pick you up at that time.
4. **TELEPHONE CALLS** - The Camp Director's phone number is 254-833-4111. Family members may call with any questions, concerns or statements. The call will be returned as necessary at convenience. There will be designated times allowed for campers to use their phones. Phone usage outside of designated times is prohibited. F&LWC is in no way responsible for camper's phones.

**CELL PHONES**- Cell phones are for camper/parent communication only and may be used with permission, under the supervision of a staff member if the need arises. At all other times the phones should be turned off and put away. F&LWC is not responsible for any lost, stolen or damaged phones.

5. **TUITION, DISCOUNTS & REFUNDS** - The total balance of **\$110** is due with your application OR by **5/20/18**. A late charge of \$20 will be inquired after this date. For accurate record keeping, an application must be filed for every camper. No refund will be given when the camper leaves the camp because of homesickness, discipline, family vacations, etc. No discount will be given for those arriving late.
6. **VISITORS** - Camp Hot Pursuit maintains a very active schedule. Therefore, unregistered visitors are discouraged. When a visitor does come, he / she must immediately check in with a Camp Manager to receive permission to be on campus. All visitors must obey all camp rules and leave before lights out. Food will not be supplied to any unexpected visitors.
7. **DO NOT BRING** - I-pods, MP3s, video games (or other electronic devices, matches, lighters, any form of tobacco, weapons, alcohol, drugs or medications (except as noted on the application) or questionable reading material. *F&LWC is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged items.*
